\*\*\*\* Prager 2002 Austria Wachau Wachstum Bodenstein Smaragd Rslg \$57 2007-2030 A double WOW. A refined wine that is elegant, gracious and delicious. The peach and pear combine with the minerally character to form a more perfect union. Smaragd is the highest designation of quality in the Wachau and this wine tells you why.

\*\*\*\* Prager 2002 Austria Wachau Steinriegel Federspiel \$ 35 Now-2020 I own a case of the 2001 and will buy a case of the 2002 as soon as I can. Not as intense or as great as the Smaragd, but at two-thirds the price is a very good value. The wine is bright and bracing in the mouth with a concentrated minerally character that enhances the lemon and apple flavours. One also finds notes of peaches and hazelnuts.
